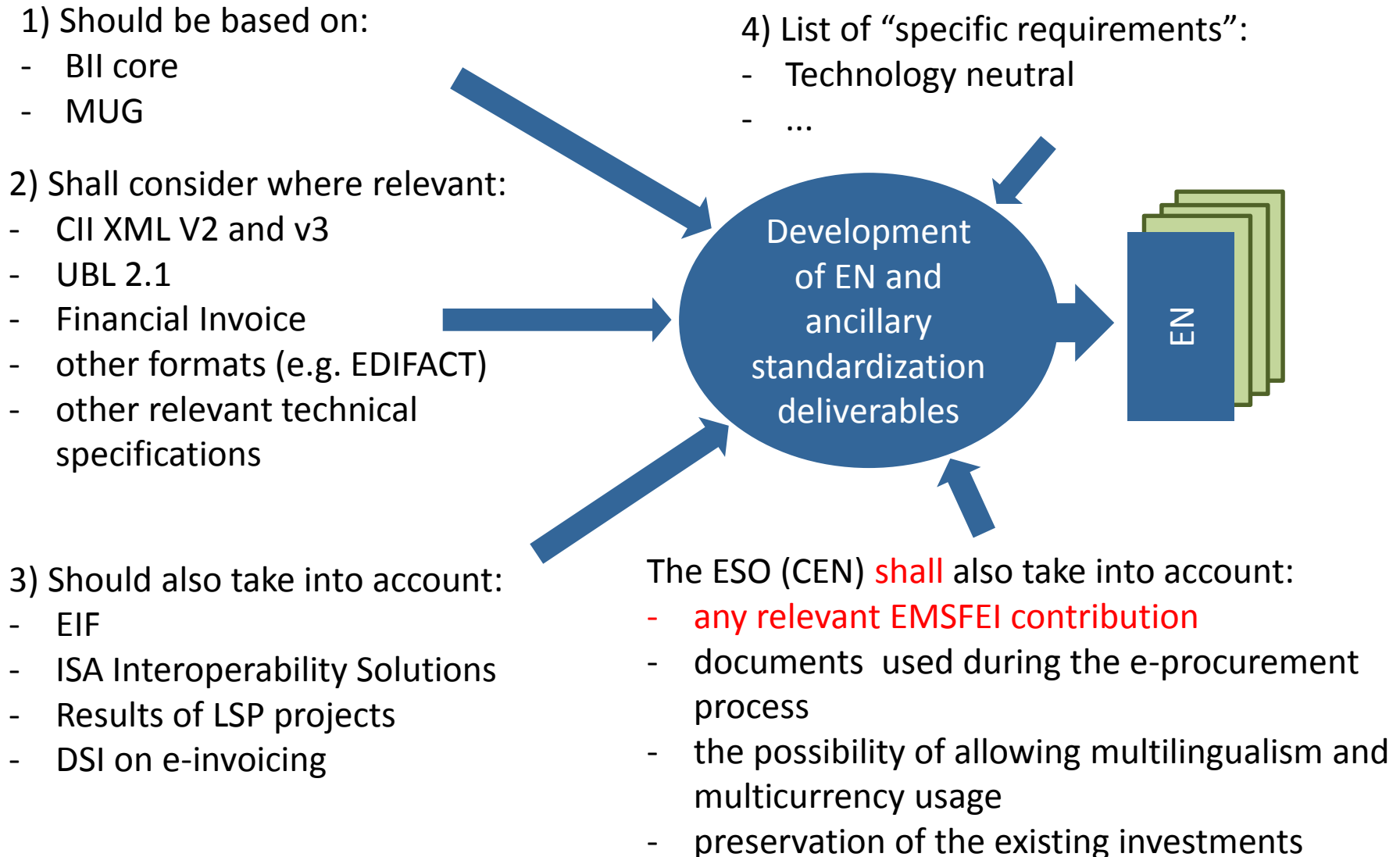

PC 434 establishment and initial decisions

- CEN BT ballot from 2014-02-05 to 2014-05-06:
approved, PC is created as CEN/TC 434
- First plenary meeting on Sep 9th, 2014 - Decisions:
 - New Work Item for the development of a European Standard for ‘Semantic data model for the core elements of an electronic invoice’ - Approved unanimously and 18 CEN members (NSO) committed to participate
 - Task force for EN development established, first F2F in Brussels, Oct 1-2, 2014
 - Volunteer team drafted a proposal for EN development approach, organization and planning
 - Unanimously approved liaisons with CEN BII and eBES Workshops and with OpenPEPPOL AISBL
 - Next PC434 plenary in Wien on Jan 14-15, 2015

PC 434 potentially critical issues

- Directive 2014/55/EU Article 7: Receipt and processing of electronic invoices
 - **Member States shall ensure that contracting authorities and contracting entities receive and process electronic invoices which comply with the European standard on electronic invoicing** whose reference has been published pursuant to Article 3(2) and with any of the syntaxes on the list published pursuant to Article 3(2)
- To enable the fulfilment of this requirement PC 434 is preparing a first draft by Dec 18th, trying to keep the core semantic data model as limited as possible
- Comments on this first draft from EMSFEI/EXEP are essential for PC434. Requests for substantial changes during the formal enquiry (Aug-Dec 2014) would introduce delays
- In order to keep the number of core elements limited it can be necessary to change the existing legislation in some member states
- Advice from AGR, especially about how to deal with specific national requirements, can be very important for PC434
